DESCRIPTION

This educational activity is designed for prescribers of controlled substances. The training will provide practical, clinically relevant information on prescribing opioids safely and will focus on strategies for reducing adverse outcomes resulting from inappropriate prescribing, misuse, and abuse of opioids.

FACULTY

Dr. James Finch is a Family Physician by training who, for many years, has worked primarily with patients with substance abuse disorders. Certified in Addiction Medicine by the American Board of Addiction Medicine and a Fellow of the American Society of Addiction Medicine, he is the Director of Physician Education for the Governor's Institute on Substance Abuse and has developed the clinical training program for Project Lazarus Chronic Pain Initiative.

While on faculty at Duke University Medical Center, he held joint appointments in Family Medicine and Psychiatry, and helped found and direct the Duke Addictions Program. After leaving Duke, he worked for many years in community mental health settings in North Carolina while continuing to be active in training initiatives nationally and internationally. Most recently, he served on the expert panel convened by the Federation of State Medical Boards to revise and update its policy on the use of opioid medications in the treatment of chronic pain. He is the medical director of an addiction and mental health collaborative practice in Durham called Changes By Choice.
