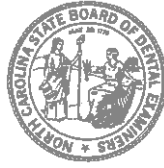

Dear Ms. Simpson:

You did not renew your dental hygiene license for 2018 before the extended deadline of March 31, 2018 and your license lapsed as of April 1, 2018. Upon reviewing information gathered by the Investigative Panel along with disclosure by you, it was determined that you worked as a dental hygienist on at least three (3) occasions after your license to practice dental hygiene had lapsed on April 1, 2018.

Based on the information available, the Board has concluded that you practiced dental hygiene in violation of G.S. 90-233(c) which states that you may only practice while your license is in effect. For this reason, the Board proposes to officially reprimand you. An official reprimand includes placing a copy of this letter in your permanent file, posting a copy of the reprimand on the Board's website for approximately three months, and sending a copy to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

We understand that you have filed a petition for your license to be reinstated. If you accept the proposed reprimand, the Board's Investigative Panel will recommend the reinstatement of your license, which is subject to the full Board's approval. If you elect to accept the reprimand, please indicate your acceptance by signing below and returning this letter to the Board office.

If you elect not to accept the reprimand, you have the right to request a formal hearing regarding both the allegations of unauthorized practice and regarding your petition for reinstatement. The requests must be in writing and must be made within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this letter.

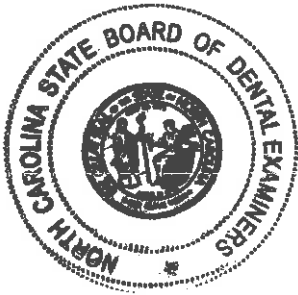


